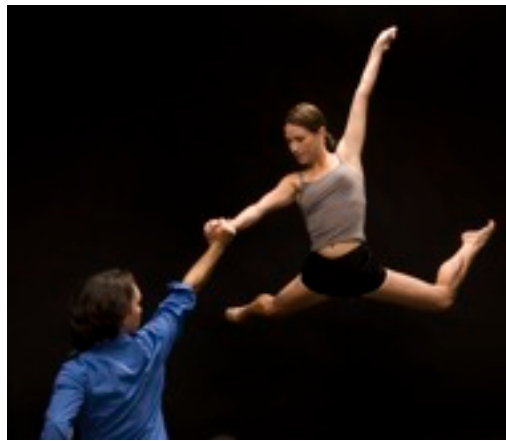

Pure Dance Workshops

Dancing Through History

Apex is involved in creating a unique performance workshop, which teaches history through dance. Inspired by important historical people and events we have created dances that will tell the stories and ordeals of key moments in history.

The workshop has a dual role of teaching students about the elements of dance including: the basics of locomotor and non-locomotor movement, the different styles of dance, basic dance composition, and many others. The workshop includes a companion syllabus that provides students with in-depth information on the peoples and events being danced. The workshop also provides teachers with tools to foster the students' connections between what they have seen in the performance with what they learn from the syllabus.
